Shapes Around Us

Color, count, and name

Six shapes to know

1

Circle

Round, no corners.

Example: A clock face, a wheel.

2

Square

4 equal sides, 4 corners.

Example: A window, a chess board.

3

Triangle

3 sides, 3 corners.

Example: A slice of pizza, a roof.

4

Rectangle

4 sides, 4 corners. Two long, two short.

Example: A door, a book.

5

Hexagon

6 sides, 6 corners.

Example: A honeycomb cell.

6

Oval

Like a stretched circle.

Example: An egg, a racetrack.
