## For supervising staff

These activities work alone or in pairs. Each one keeps children calmly occupied for 10–15 minutes. No glue, no scissors, no mess. Print one set per child or laminate for re-use with whiteboard pens.

## Six activities in this pack

<b>1 — Spot the difference</b> Two near-identical pictures. Find 8 differences. (Page 2)	<b>2 — Word maze</b> Find a path through the maze of words to spell a hidden message. (Page 3)
<b>3 — Quick crossword</b> Easy 6-clue crossword themed around school. (Page 4)	<b>4 — Drawing prompts</b> Six 'finish this drawing' prompts on one page. (Page 5)
<b>5 — Number puzzle</b> Easy logic puzzle — fill in the missing numbers. (Page 6)	<b>6 — Story-starter sheet</b> A first sentence; child writes the next paragraph. (Page 7)
