Board game — maps, capitals, and physical features

How to play

Rules for 2–4 players

- Players: 2–4
- 4 card types: CONTINENTS (blue), COUNTRIES & CAPITALS (green), RIVERS & MOUNTAINS (brown), CLIMATE & BIOMES (orange)
- On your turn, draw a card from any pile.
- Correct → roll die and move. Wrong → stay.
- GLOBE SPINNER squares: roll again. WEATHER DELAY squares: miss a turn.
- First to reach the Equator (finish line) wins.

Sample questions — Countries & Capitals

- What is the capital city of France? (Paris)
- What is the capital of Australia? (Canberra — not Sydney)
- Which country has the largest population in the world? (China / or India — both acceptable as of 2023+)
- Name the capital of Brazil. (Brasília — not Rio de Janeiro)
- What is the capital of Japan? (Tokyo)

Sample questions — Rivers & Mountains



- What is the longest river in the world? (The Nile — or Amazon, depending on measurement)
- On which continent is the Amazon river? (South America)
- What is the highest mountain in the world? (Mount Everest)
- In which country is Mount Everest? (Nepal / Tibet border)
- Name a river in the UK. (Thames, Severn, Trent, Tyne, etc.)
