## Key facts

- Canada's huge boreal forest is home to many animals.
- These include moose, black bears, wolves, beavers and lynx.
- Many grow thick fur for the cold winters.
- Some, like bears, hibernate through the coldest months.

- Hibernate — to sleep through winter.
- Predator — an animal that hunts others.

## Built for the forest

Forest animals are suited to cold, snowy winters — with thick fur, clever feeding, and behaviours like hibernation.

Forests link animals together in food chains, from plants to plant-eaters to predators like wolves and lynx.
