## Maths reference

Key facts at a glance

- NUMBER LINE: 0 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20
- DOUBLES:  $2+2=4$   $3+3=6$   $4+4=8$   $5+5=10$   $6+6=12$   $7+7=14$   $8+8=16$   $9+9=18$   $10+10=20$
- NUMBER BONDS TO 10:  $1+9$   $2+8$   $3+7$   $4+6$   $5+5$
- NUMBER BONDS TO 20:  $11+9$   $12+8$   $13+7$   $14+6$   $15+5$   $16+4$   $17+3$   $18+2$   $19+1$
- PLACE VALUE: H T U (hundreds tens units/ones)
- SHAPES: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, pentagon (5), hexagon (6), octagon (8)

## English reference

Grammar and punctuation at a glance

- CAPITAL LETTERS: start of sentence, names, places, months, days, title 'I'
- FULL STOPS: end of a statement
- QUESTION MARKS: end of a question
- EXCLAMATION MARKS: for surprise, shock, or strong feeling
- COMMAS: lists, fronted adverbials (After a long day, ...), clauses
- SPEECH MARKS: " before and after what someone says



- APOSTROPHES: contraction (it's = it is) OR possession (the dog's bowl)
- PARAGRAPH: new idea = new paragraph. Press Enter twice.
- TRICKY SPELLINGS: because, friend, people, said, their/there/they're, weather/whether, which/witch
