Even and Odd

Pair them up to find out

How to tell

EVEN numbers can be split into pairs with NONE left over. So 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 are even. ODD numbers always have ONE left over when you try to pair them. So 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 are odd. Tip: even numbers always end in 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8.

Sort these numbers

EVEN	ODD	

Cut out and sort: 4, 7, 12, 9, 20, 15, 3, 8, 21, 30, 17, 16, 11, 100, 53, 44, 62, 99

1. What is the next EVEN number after 24?
2. What is the next ODD number after 19?
3. Is 0 even or odd? Why?
4. If you add two even numbers, is the answer always even? Try a few.
5. If you add an even and an odd number, what do you get?
