<p><b>We're more alike than we think</b></p> <p>We all want to feel safe. To be loved. To learn things. To laugh. To matter. Underneath the differences, we have a LOT in common.</p>

- Be curious, not judgmental — questions are good
- Stand up for someone if you see them being treated unfairly because they're different
