# My Reading Passport

Every book is a journey

## How to use

Print the booklet pages double-sided on A4. Fold in half and staple along the spine — you have a small reading passport. Give one to each child at the start of the year. They fill it in as they finish books — at home, in school, library books, bedtime reads, comics, audiobooks. Anything counts. NO COMPETITION between children. No 'book of the week' winner. The passport is the child's own record. The teacher's job is to ask once a week, with genuine interest: 'What did you read this week? What was it like?' The research is consistent: children who read for pleasure for 20+ minutes a day make far more progress than children who don't. The passport doesn't enforce — it celebrates.
