# Rounding

To the nearest 10 and 100

## The rounding rule

Look at the digit AFTER the place you're rounding to. If it's 5 or more, round UP. If it's 4 or less, round DOWN. So to round 47 to the nearest 10, look at the 7 — round UP to 50. To round 432 to the nearest 100, look at the 3 (the tens digit) — round DOWN to 400.
