## Greetings & farewells

Spanish	Sounds like	Meaning
Hola	OH-la	Hello
Buenos días	BWAY-nos DEE-as	Good morning
Buenas tardes	BWAY-nas TAR-des	Good afternoon
Buenas noches	BWAY-nas NO-ches	Good evening / night
Adiós	ah-dee-OS	Goodbye
Hasta luego	AS-ta LWAY-go	See you later
Hasta mañana	AS-ta man-YA-na	See you tomorrow
¿Cómo estás?	KOH-mo ess-TAS	How are you?
Estoy bien	ess-TOY bee-EN	I'm well
Más o menos	mas oh MEH-nos	So-so
Por favor	por fa-VOR	Please
Muchas gracias	MOO-chas GRA-thee-as	Thank you very much
De nada	deh NA-da	You're welcome
¿Cómo te llamas?	KOH-mo teh YA-mas	What's your name?
Me llamo...	meh YA-mo	My name is...



## Punctuation note for teachers

Spanish uses inverted punctuation: ¿...? and ¡...! at the START of questions and exclamations. Don't worry if children miss it at first — focus on speaking. Written precision can come later.
