Basic colours

Masculine and feminine forms

RED — rojo / roja (RO-ho)	BLUE — azul (a-THOOL) — same for both
GREEN — verde (VAIR-deh) — same for both	YELLOW — amarillo / amarilla (a-ma-REE-yo)
BLACK — negro / negra (NEH-gro)	WHITE — blanco / blanca (BLAN-ko)
ORANGE — naranja (na-RAN-ha) — same for both	PINK — rosa (RO-sa) — same for both
PURPLE — morado / morada (mo-RA-do)	BROWN — marrón (ma-RON) — same for both
Colours ending in -o change to -a for feminine. Others (azul, verde) don't change.	

Useful sentences

Putting it all together



¿Cuántos años tienes? (KWAN-toss AHN-yos tee-EN-ess) — How old are you?	Tengo diez años. (TEN-go dee-eth AHN-yos) — I am 10 years old.
¿Cuál es tu color favorito? — What is your favourite colour?	Mi color favorito es el azul. — My favourite colour is blue.
El balón es rojo. — The ball is red.	La pelota es roja. — The ball (small/feminine) is red.
REMEMBER: in Spanish, the colour goes AFTER the noun (una camisa azul = a blue shirt).
