# Tally Charts and Pictograms

Reading and making simple data displays

## Tally marks

One mark for each thing counted. After four marks, draw the fifth as a slash across the previous four. Count tallies in fives — quicker than counting one by one.

## Use the data — favorite fruit survey

1. Apple: 8, Banana: 5, Orange: 6, Grape: 11, Strawberry: 4. Draw a tally chart for this data.
2. Which fruit was most popular? Which was least?
3. How many MORE pupils chose grape than strawberry?
4. How many pupils were surveyed altogether?
5. Now draw a pictogram of the same data. Use 1 picture = 1 vote.
6. If 1 picture = 2 votes instead, how would your pictogram change for grape?
